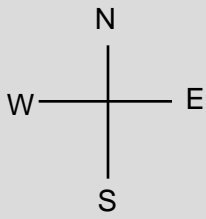


Note: For simplicity I have drawn Marco Island as a solid land mass. Actually it is a maze of "finger canals" carved by developers so that almost everyone has a canal in their backyard so they can be "on the water." When driving around Marco you don't see all the canals because they are behind the homes. Look at a street map of Marco and you'll see what I mean. Of course there are a lot more roads than I've drawn. I've just drawn the ones that get you to the beach, as on all the other islands in the book.
